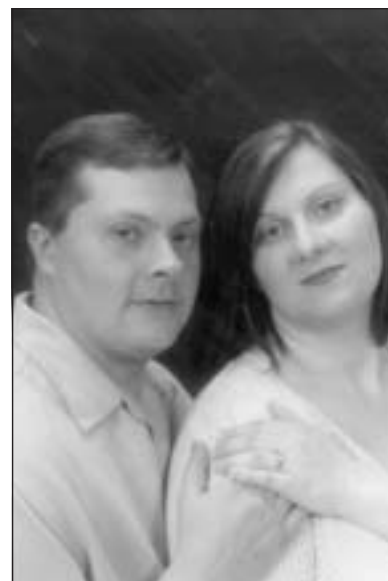
Cornwall-Kaputa
