

Stumpf's Level 5 gymnasts compete at Lucky Stars invite



The Level 5 team from Stumpf's Gymnastics Center recently competed in the Lucky Stars Invitational hosted by Stroups Gymnastics in Jamestown, N.Y. Nine girls placed in the all-around finals, and two gymnasts won first place on individual events. Members of the

The Level 5 team from Stumpf's Gymnastics Center competed in the Lucky Stars Invitational hosted by Stroups Gymnastics in Jamestown, N.Y.

The team endured some strict judging and finished with nine girls placing in the all-around finals and two gymnasts winning first place on individual events.

The youngest age group saw six gymnasts place in the top 15 all-around and earned a total of 22 medals in the event finals. Additionally, Lacey Woite struck gold on uneven bars (9.250) and bronze on vault (8.850). Woite was fourth in all-around competition.

Mackenzie Donner finished sixth on vault (8.750) for eighth all-around. Katie Uba was ninth all-around and won silver on floor exercise (9.050). Allison Scumaci won bronze on floor (8.950), placed fourth on balance beam (9.000) and finished tenth all-around. Rebecca Reinhardt finished fourth on uneven bars (9.050) and 11th in the all-around. Miranda Roberson won silver on beam (9.275) and finished 13th all-around, while Emily Schulenberg placed 10th on floor (8.650).

Kaily Martens was third place all-around in the 10-year-old age group with a team-high 35.625. Additionally, Martens won gold on beam (9.325) and bronze on vault (8.550) and uneven bars (9.100). Teammate Samantha Maniccia finished sixth on vault and eighth on beam, floor and all-around.

Rachel Kania competed for the 11-year-olds and earned a bronze medal on vault (8.800). Kania was also fourth on floor and fifth in all-around.

Eleven-year-old Madeline Meyer earned a personal best on uneven bars (8.350), as did teammate Jackie Schachtner, whose 8.600 placed eighth in the 12-and-over division.

Stumpf's optional teams win first at Jamestown

The optional teams from Stumpf's Gymnastics Center won first-place honors at the Lucky Stars Invitational hosted by Stroups Gymnastics of Jamestown. Individually, the girls were also unbeatable, with three winning all-around titles and each girl placing in the all-around finals.

The team was led by Courtney Connors, who scored a 37.250 all-around score on her way to becoming the Level 10 all-around champion. Connors also swept

the event finals, which were highlighted by a 9.600 on floor exercise. Kristina Arcury finished second all-around, as well as on uneven bars, balance beam and floor exercise. She was third on vault.

Amanda Recor won silver on uneven bars, beam and floor and finished third all-around. Recor was also the silver medalist on vault with a 9.275.

The younger division of Level 9 was won by Kailyn Arcury, who had a 36.800 all-around score.

Arcury also swept the event finals, earning in the nines on each event.

Teammate Erin Hamister won the silver on vault, uneven bars, beam and floor and was second all-around.

Melissa Blando was the all-around champion of her middle age group with a score of 34.800 and the gold medalist on vault, uneven bars and floor. Katie Kaiser tied Blando's all-around score to earn second place in her older age group. Additionally, Kaiser was the beam champion with a 9.300 and placed second on floor and third on uneven bars.

Alyssa Billittier was Stumpf's lone competitor for Level 7. Billittier won silver on beam with a 9.375, placed fourth on uneven bars and finished seventh all-around.

Level 6 performs well at meet

Stumpf's Level 6 team gave a strong performance at the Lucky Stars Invitational in Jamestown, N.Y.

The team combined for 19 medals in the event finals and placed four girls on the all-around podium, including an all-around champion.

Shannon Martensen of the 10-11-year-olds had a fantastic meet, winning all-around by five hundredths of a point with a score of 37.350. Martensen also won gold on uneven bars (9.500), silver on balance beam (9.450) and bronze on floor exercise (9.250). Teammate Lily Szafranski gave another great performance, winning gold on vault (9.425) and floor (9.400) and silver on uneven bars (9.500). Her 37.325 finished second all-around. Michaela Stumpf finished ninth on vault (9.175), beam (9.100) and in all-around. Teammate Taylor Balsler was sixth on vault (9.200).

Callie Flanagan competed in the 12-and-over division and finished the day with a silver medal on floor exercise (9.175), fifth place on uneven bars (9.200) and ninth all-around. Kristen Kelly won a medal on beam with a 9.100, and Ashley Materise returned from an injury and scored an 8.700 on vault.

Stumpf's Level 8 earns trophies at invitational

Audrey Mulhisen finished eighth all-around and won silver
