Couple united in West Seneca

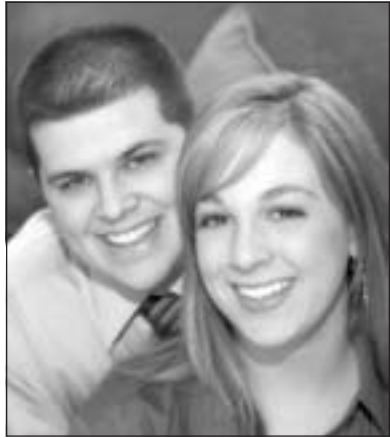
