Erie County Department of Public Works is planning a project that will reconstruct the existing pavement, construct two additional through lanes and add a two-way center turn lane on East Robinson/North French Roads. The project will also include operational improvements at various intersections throughout the project limits. The project will start at Niagara Falls Boulevard (U.S. Rte 62) and extend to Sweet Home Road (CR 301) generally along the existing roadway alignment. The total length of the project is 1.2 + miles, all within the Town of Amherst.

Information relative to the project may be obtained at the office of the Commissioner, Erie County Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, 95 Franklin Street, Buffalo, NY 14202.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERST, NEW YORK, ADOPTED APRIL 16, 2007, APPROPRIATING \$483,000 FOR THE INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT OF FACILITIES OF SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 1, INCLUDING THE EXPENDITURE OF APPROXIMATELY \$258,000 TOWN FUNDS TO PAY A PART OF SAID APPROPRIATION, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$225,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO FINANCE THE BALANCE OF SAID APPROPRIATION

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the increase and improvement of facilities of Sanitary Sewer District No. 1, consisting of the replacement of approximately 2,593 lineal feet of 8-inch and 10-inch sanitary sewer line along Lebrun Road, Lebrun Circle and a portion of Jasper Drive, including manhole modifications and replacements, lateral branches, new house service connections, appurtenances, backfill, restoration of site and other related and ancillary work, at the estimated maximum cost of \$483,000.

The amount of obligations to be issued is not to exceed \$225,000, with the expectation that the \$258,000 balance of such cost shall be paid from Town funds available or to become available for such purpose.

The period of probable usefulness is forty (40) years.
