A July 2007 wedding is planned at the Glen Oaks Country Club, East Amherst.



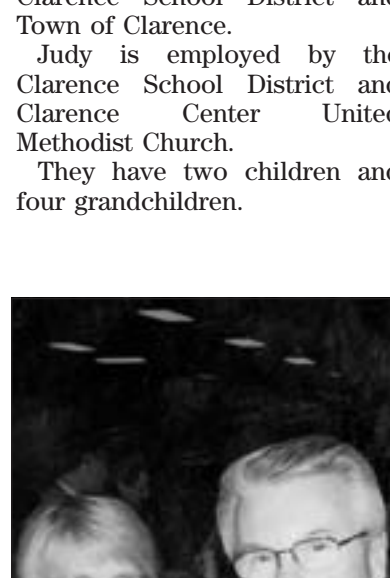
Martha Baker and Corey Miller
