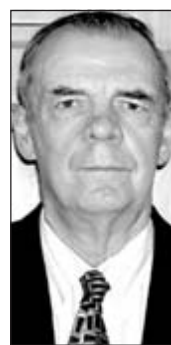

**Community Development Block Grant and Amherst-Cheektowaga-Tonawanda HOME Consortium FY 2008 Action Plan Public Review Period**
