All citizens have the right to be informed on decisions made by their elected officials and how those decisions were reached. Without such right, government could act secretly and without responsibility to the citizens who voted them into office.

Publication of official minutes of local government proceedings can reveal information as routine as approval of new traffic signals, or as crucial as a decision on tax rates.
